UPDATE: 33 ONLINE PARTICIPANTS, 9 IN-PERSON

PRESIDENT

3CAA and 3CATA Covid workgroups have not met and Brandon is optimistic they won't have to meet again. New committees have been formed and we will discuss today. Management Council met and one of the subcommittees minimum standards for infrastructure group- best way to support student athletes better. Either medical, coaches, counselors, etc. Survey data was gathered and will be sent out. Program Review process, the athletic training side of this conversation- the Med Advisory Board will work on the formula for how many Ats each school will need. Appropriate coverage for medical services so the College Presidents can see that. Comment- data about hardships with hiring right now. Comment about full time positions as opposed to part time positions. New grads with a Masters degree don't want 20 hour/week jobs. Raising the rate of pay is one suggestion (40\$hr). Difficulty getting help in the South? At Victor Valley they had 6 applicants/5 qualified, came down to 4. Barstow only had one apply. Maria- depends on location and time of year. El Camino 12 applied. Comment the North only has one grad program. El Camino pay- 62K a year 12 months. Discussion about standardizing classifications statewide. Hartnell hired 67K (2 applied) part timers 50/hr. Professional Advancement Committee may take a look at this moving forward with a draft. Legislative committee has discussed this as well.


North VP



LEGISLATION REVIEW

2 pieces of legislation. PPEs for nurse practitioners to sign off. Feedback has been acceptable. Good place moving forward to get it passed.

Not as much legislation as there has been. VB wants to start games 2-3 days sooner because they want to end their season sooner. Move the timeline forward. For schools that don't do summer training will this impact them because of fewer training days before first game? Will other sports want this now?

XC looking for more competitors in their post season. Trying to increase more than what they can?

Water polo state tournament expanding to 8 teams to a three-day tournament

Updating Environmental/Heat legislation. Wet bulb temp as numbers to go off of. This gives guidelines to when to modify/postpone/cancel competitions. This currently doesn't exist. Trying to give concrete guidelines. Concerns- numbers are low for competitions. Schools in hot areas wouldn't be able to play games in Sept/Oct. The medical advisory board looking for feedback in order to fine tune this. ACSM came out with a recent guideline in 2021- it covers competitions as well. Our state is so diverse with desert, coastal, inland, trying to create a safe playing environment. Trying to adjust the practice and competition part of this legislation. This is based on published medical standards. Robust comments about this legislation.
