President - Maria Castro:

Management council meeting proposed a lot of legislation that impacts ATs, MC has major concerns with some (FB legislation for 3 games and then redshirt has tracking problems, may not go through as is). # of seasons OEC to try to get a certain number of games across the board P15- lets baseball play 8 games and have it not count- tracking a problem again. Keeping her eye on these and will update if there are any. Unattached people- individual sport athletes — still have to be on form 3 but they wouldn't have access to funding. As well as high school student athletes coming on campus for a try out.



Put in place committees so everyone has a role and a say in what goes on. Have a voice at the AD meetings, not complaining, but via points. Annual meeting for just CCCATA- in talks with Renaissance hotel in Palm Springs, trying to launch May 31st and June 1st. Afternoon session 1-6 on that Friday and coming in Sat morning at 12 and then have awards luncheon to honor our own. She will ask if anyone has any interest in speaking within our organization. Aiming for 10-12 CEUs. Working with the hotel to figure out what the space looks like.

NORTH VP - WARREN VOYCE:

Continue to see more positions opening up with fewer candidates applying and some positions going unfilled. Impacts medical services at these colleges. Doesn't know what the solution is.

SOUTH VP - TONY ONTIVEROS:

Also seeing positions open up with more positions and hopefully our graduating students will start to apply for these positions. Question for the group- will schools be willing to take new grads? Is that a great enough qualification? David Beymer- needs to be written into the job description about having two years experience but not necessarily certified.





Treasurer – Todd Babcock:

4,320 Membership is 53% of total. There is another 3K out there for us to collect. Website update-working on it- trying to work on the organization of the website and he launched it and it crashed. Then it crashed and is trying to revamp it. Paid the taxes for the year. Dues payments: Zelle works well for paying dues. Please don't send cash, checks and invoice (takes a while). Shout out to Abi from El Camino and a student from Long Beach performed CPR on an official. Saved a life!


SPORTS REP CHAIR - JAMIE DEROLLO - NONE

CONFERENCE UPDATES

North

Big 8 – Jamie DeRollo: none

Coast – David Beymer: Positions opened that can't get filled. Soccer double headers taking an AT out of the room. Non-traditional baseball and softball scheduling 8 hours of games. Coaches asking for forgiveness and not permission. Discussion: is there any legislative actions that can happen? It is getting worse. Rural school with 2 ATs, XC and soccer at the same time, one AT had covid and the AD did not cancel any events and AT went to the soccer game and problems occurred at the XC meet. Open for discussion about long term implications. Need to have a plan in place if this happens again. From the State, maybe have a position statement? Trying to prevent loss of life and be proactive. Maria- part of the problem is there are no state regulations. Our bylaws have that there needs to be a certified available. EMT? Ambulance? The school brought in an EMT but that isn't equivalent. She will bring this up to ADs group about the liability impact. It is a punishable offense and sanctions are not being utilized. Medical safety bylaws are being ignored and there needs to be enforcement. Staffing needs to be improved and utilizing the staffing document to help schools figure out how many ATs they need. Joe Parry- baseball non-traditional playing 2-7 inning games. What is appropriate for events? BS took out double headers years ago for safety reasons and why are they coming back now? Warren- we could introduce legislation to limit the contests? Wouldn't pass. The emergency event in the North- support the ATs up there and they did everything they could to provide the necessary





coverage. Do we punish the school for an unforeseen circumstance? Ask the ADs what they would like us to do here? Tough scenario.

Golden Valley – Haley Mulvihill: No big updates. BS non-traditional says "date" as opposed to contest as opposed to a time cap. Limited staffing with all day BS events. Change wording?

Bay Valley – Brandon Lucas: Staffing is an issue. Contra Costa, Woodland, and College of Alameda are hiring and need an AT. Bringing it up in the conference with 2 sport schools. The Board of the CCCAA may need to send letters to college presidents (Maria's idea) and show the value of having the AT position as opposed to jus hiring for game management. Any other suggestions let her know.

Central Valley – David Holford: New rep. Hiring West Coalinga in the future, Columbia hiring Juan Lopez, Merced hiring, added Madera CC and they are looking to add sports., new ATs. Fresno City have 3 ATs now. Fresno States Masters of AT and 8 students are graduating and some are interested in CC positions. Make sure wording in job description for non-certified internships to go towards experience.


South

Orange Empire – Nate Swift: Non-traditional is a lot right now. Statewide this needs to be addressed. There isn't enough staffing to cover all the events including NTS. Zoom meeting conference sponsorship with different entities. Like a hospital sponsoring the ATs at a high school.

South Coast – Abi Francisco: Hosting NTS and potentially swim. Her school doesn't have friction with NTS- they are available not present. Stagger hours throughout the day if possible. Memo from Mt Sac AT hosting soccer state and women's volleyball state on the same weekend. About to host conference championships for soccer.

Inland Empire – Amy Wilkin: (audio problems and I didn't hear the beginning of this update) Updates on the Copper Mountain may have a temporary person. Ashley Reamer is at San Bernardino. NTS side with strong communication with the AD so there isn't approval if there are other events.

Western States – Alexis: No updates





Pacific Coast – Tosh Tepraseuth: Positions Imperial Valley 2^{nd} AT, one of the goals with FB inadequate staffing, those FB schools trying to get a 3^{rd} . Southwestern just hired 3^{rd} (1^{st}) Mesa has been approved for 3^{rd} for summer of '24.
